2. Purpose of processing

The purpose of the processing of your personal data is the provision of electron microscopy service examinations at the Laboratory for Electron Microscopy (LEM). Your data will only be processed by KIT insofar as this is necessary for the purpose of operating the services used for this purpose, including their is required.

3. Legal basis for processing

For KIT members, the legal basis for the processing of personal data is the performance of public tasks pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 subpara. 1 lit. e GDPR in conjunction with § 2

Baden-Württemberg State Higher Education Act (LHG).

For non-KIT members, the legal basis for the processing of personal data is the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party, and Implementation of pre-contractual measures pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 subpara. 1 lit. b GDPR.

4. Type and scope of data processing

If you have submitted an application for electron microscopy service examinations on Electron Microscopy Laboratory (LEM), the following personal data subjects will be Data collected and stored:

- Surname and first name
- Company/Institution Affiliation
- Address
- Email

- Telephone number
- Scope of the investigation

We process your personal data for invoicing purposes and for our employees to contact you in order to arrange an appointment with you. Access to the personal data is only granted to the responsible employees of KIT. A transfer of the data by KIT to a third country takes place does not take place.

5. Storage period

Your data will be stored for as long as it is necessary for the provision of the electron microscopy service examinations and there are legal retention obligations. After expiry of the statutory retention periods (in particular tax and commercial regulations), your data will be deleted.

6. Your rights

With regard to personal data concerning you, you have the following rights vis-à-vis us:

- Right to confirmation as to whether data concerning you is being processed and to information about the data being processed, to further information about data processing and to copies of the data (Article 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification or completion of incorrect or incomplete data (Article 16 GDPR)
- Right to immediate deletion of data concerning you (Article 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 GDPR)
- Right to receive the data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, provided that the processing is based on consent in accordance with Article 6(1), first subparagraph, letter a, or Article 9(2)(a), or on a contract in accordance with Article 6(1), first subparagraph, point (b) (Article 20 GDPR)
- Right to object to the future processing of data concerning you, provided that the data is processed in accordance with Article 6 (1) (e) or (f) GDPR (Article 21 GDPR)

You also have the right to complain to the supervisory authority about the processing of personal data concerning you by KIT (Article 77 GDPR). The supervisory authority within the meaning of Article 51 (1) GDPR on KIT is according to Section 25 (1) LDSG: The State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information Baden-Württemberg (<https://www.baden-wuerttemberg.datenschutz.de/>)
